**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

On a motion made by Ms. Cueto and a second by Ms. Luetkemyer, the Board approved the minutes of the October 22, 2020 Board Meeting.

**REPORTS:**

**Finance Committee:**

Ms. Cueto reported that the Finance Committee met November 10, 2020 at noon via Zoom. Ms. Cueto. Ms. Cueto recommends that the Board approve the following items.

1. Establishment of the CY 2021 County budget at \$4,360,000.
2. Contingent upon adoption of an increase to the Mental Health Board's 2020 tax extension of no less than \$352,000, to provide a like amount of funding to the St. Clair County Jail to continue the expansion of mental health services for detainees in CY 2021.

On a recommendation from Mr. Kernan, and a second from Mr. Baugh, the Board approved the report.

**Associate Director's Report:**

Ms. Nesbit briefed the Board members in three areas: 1) IDHS released new COVID guidelines and funded agencies are working through very tough pandemic times and restrictions. 2) The SCCSPA continues to host virtual QPR trainings, is initiating a marketing committee, and making "firearm safety" a focus area. 3) A reminder to everyone to please be the example; wear masks, wash hands, watch your distance, shop small, shop local.

**Executive Director's Report:**

Mr. Rosenzweig provided additional information regarding the 2021 County budget and the funding of mental health services at the jail beginning January of 2021. He also reported on the re-engagement of the Board sponsored First Responder and Medical Personnel Response and Support phone line. In the wake of the current surge in COVID infections, additional support to those work populations could be critical. Mr. Rosenzweig also provided an overview of the operational status of the Board office and funded services. In closing he referenced the attached End of Year Report that was prepared for County Board distribution.
